CLB is offering an exceptional opportunity to compete in the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot in Vienna, one of the largest and most prestigious competitions in the world in International Commercial Law. Approximately 300 universities from over 70 countries compete in Vienna including Harvard, Yale, and other prestigious institutions. The competition is conducted in English and deals with a commercial conflict that relates to the various areas of arbitration. The competing students will write letters of claims, legal arguments, and present their claims orally in Vienna. The team's coaches are Rachel Rhodes and Daniel Winer.



About the Competition

The competition has two stages:

- 1. Preparation in Israel** for the competition in Vienna - weekly meetings (mandatory attendance).
- 2. Competition in Vienna** -the competition will take place on April 12-18, 2019.

Application Process

Applications must be submitted by e-mail to:

1. CV in English;
2. A short paragraph of up to 250 words explaining why you would like to participate in the competition and why you should be accepted onto the team;
3. Your updated transcript

The most suitable candidates will be invited to receive interviews.

The members of the team will receive 6 credits for the course. The team members that are chosen to orally claim in Vienna will receive 2 extra credits (total of 8 credits). Team members will be able to convert their credits to be exempt from the compulsory third year seminar!
